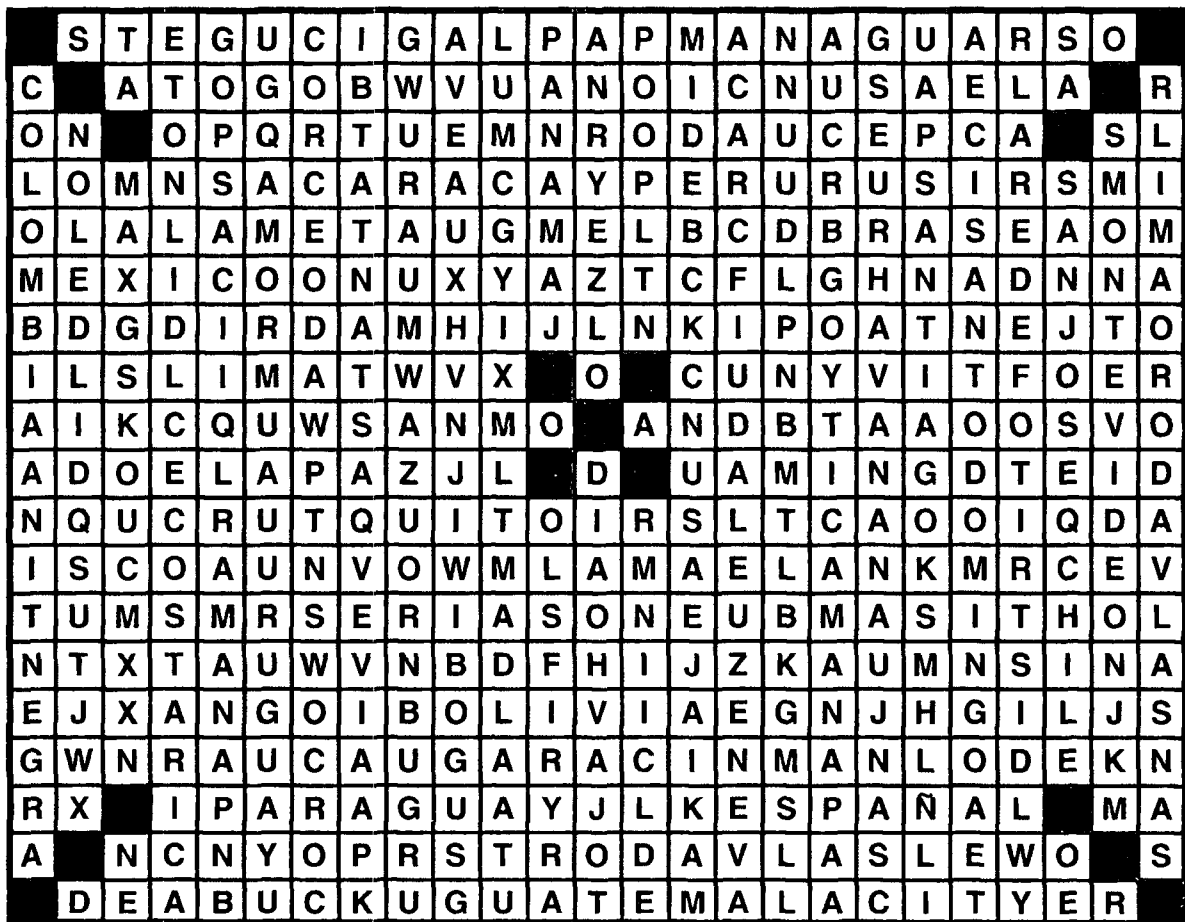


## SPANISH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES AND THEIR CAPITALS

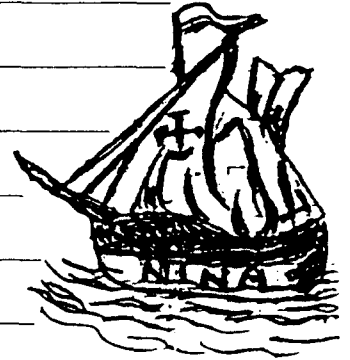
¡BÚSQUELOS! (Find them!) Circle each name in the word square; then list each country with its capital on the lines provided.

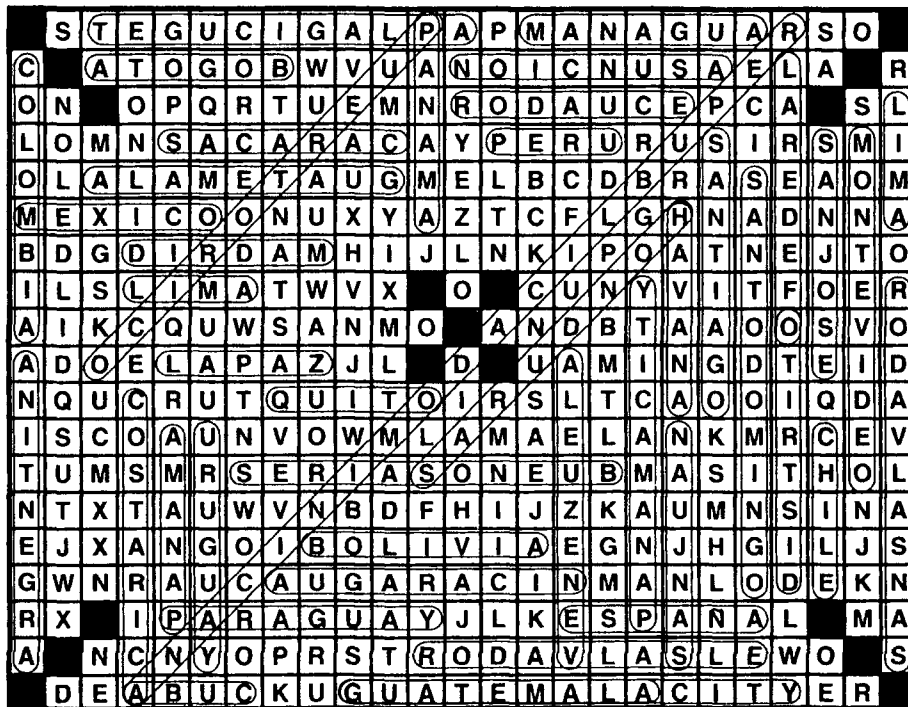
